



CHECKING FITNESS ■ More than 370 employees and their spouses came through Tennsco's Spring Wellness Fair. The fair's newest offering - an angiogram - was so popular that followup dates were set for screenings. A total of 102 folks took advantage of the six-minute procedure, a simple, non-invasive vascular screening designed to provide information about circulation and a person's risk of heart disease and stroke.
